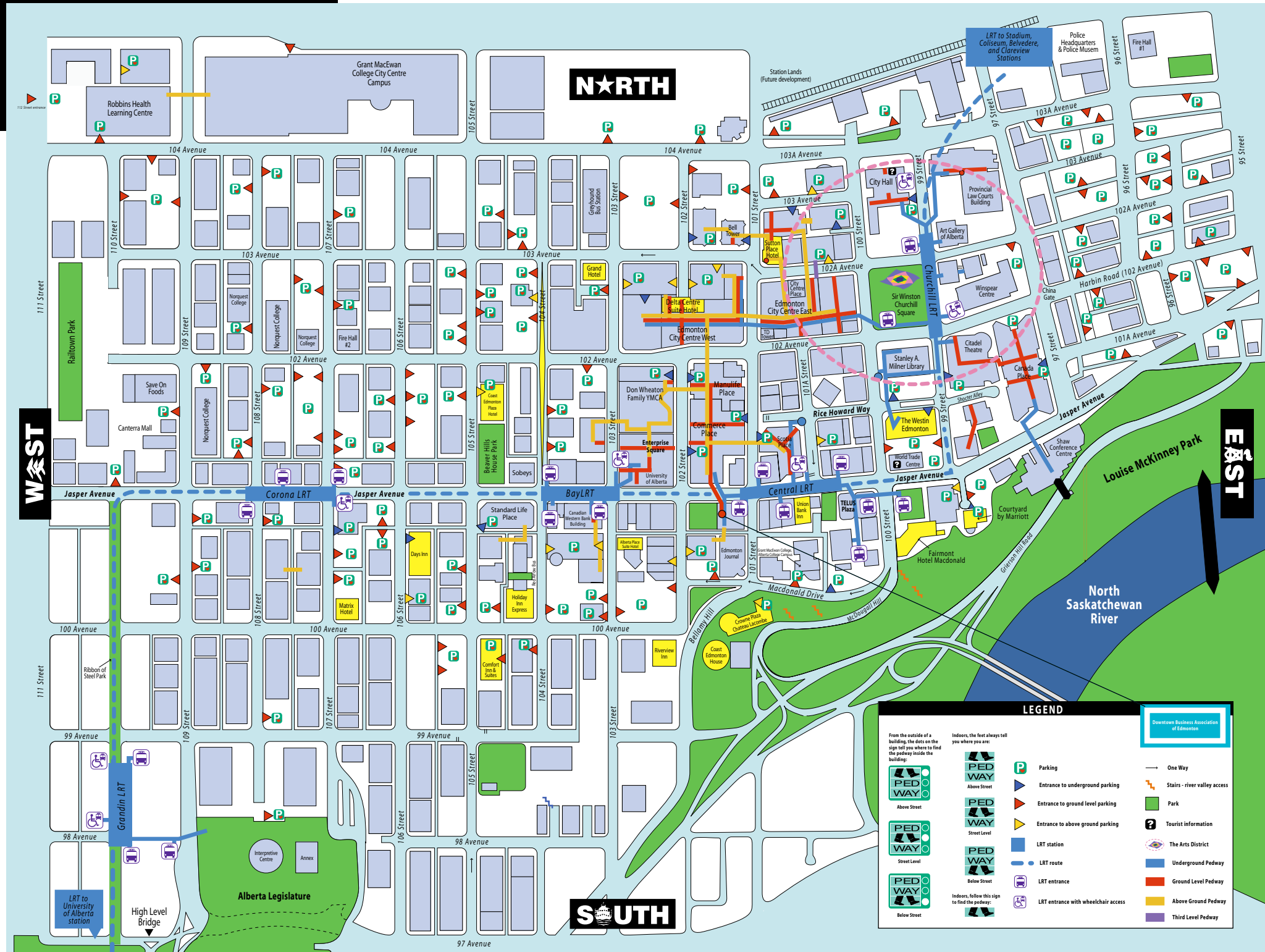

Getting around Downtown Edmonton is quite simple. From the Light Rail Transit System to buses and bicycles, there are numerous modes of transportation to take you wherever you'd like to go in the Downtown core & the entire city.

SKY SHUTTLE

Sky Shuttle is a cost-effective and convenient way to travel between Edmonton International Airport and downtown. With several downtown hotels, the Airport Express (9990 Jasper Avenue) and the Downtown Greyhound Terminal (10324-103 St.) serving as drop off and pick up points, getting to the airport has never been easier.

The service runs every 20 minutes on weekdays and every 30 minutes on weekends and holidays. Travel time from downtown to the airport is approximately 40 minutes.

Rates and Ticket Information

Sky Shuttle tickets are available at the airport Sky Shuttle booth or on the shuttles themselves. Cash and all major credit cards are accepted.

PEDWAY & LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT (LRT)

There are very few places in Downtown Edmonton that can't be reached by our very convenient pedway system (see map of Downtown). The indoor pedway system allows you to travel either underground or above ground between downtown's main shopping centres, major office buildings, and also connects you to Sir Winston Churchill Square, City Hall, and the Arts District. The pedway also links underground to three of the five downtown Light Rail Transit (LRT) stations.

The LRT provides fast and convenient service to downtown patrons travelling to or from the Alberta Legislature, the University of Alberta, Commonwealth Stadium, and other major points of interest.

There are five underground LRT stations located in the Downtown core:

Churchill Station on 99 St. & 102A Ave.
Central Station on 101 St. & Jasper Ave.
Bay Station on 104 St. & Jasper Ave.
Corona Station on 107 St. & Jasper Ave.
Grandin Station on 110 St. & 99 Ave.

What Is BusLink?

BusLink is a 24-hour automated information system you can access to get schedule and other transit information anytime you need it.

Finding My Bus Stop Number

Each bus stop has its own 4 or 5 digit bus stop number. Bus stop numbers can be found at the bottom of every bus stop sign in Edmonton. You can find out information about which buses will stop at your bus stop by entering in this number when calling BusLink.

Cash Fare*
(Exact Fare Only)

Adult (18 to 64 years) \$2.50
Youth (under 18 years) \$2.50
Senior Citizen (65+ years) \$2.50
Child (5 years and under) FREE
(Note: Child must be accompanied by a fare paying customer)

Bus Operators do not carry change. Avoid delays by having exact change ready before boarding.

*Fares valid until February 2010.

Transfers

Transfers are available free from your bus operator when you board and pay your fare. Transfers must be requested at the time the fare is paid. A transfer must be used by the person to whom it is issued within 90 minutes, in any direction. The transfer expiry time is shown at the tear.

Family Fare

The ETS Family Fare allows one adult and up to four children (ages 12 and under) to ride ETS using an ETS Day Pass. Valid all day, any day of the week. No specific "Family Pass" is being produced. Please use a regular ETS Day Pass.

DATS

DATS Monthly Passes are available to DATS registrants and permit travel on DATS and regular ETS for \$74.25 per month. DATS attendants ride free on regular ETS service when accompanied by a fare-paying DATS registrant.
