TRANSPORTATION

TAXI

The average cost in a taxi from Ottawa [Airport](#) to the downtown core is \$35 and travel time is approximately 20-minutes. Taxis are available outside Level 1 arrivals terminal.

PUBLIC TRANSIT

A 30-35-minute bus ride on [the 97 \(via Bayshore\)](#) from pillar 14 outside Level 1 arrivals terminal will take you to downtown Ottawa. Exit at Mackenzie King and walk 5 minutes to reach the hotel. Many Ottawa buses are accessible (including the 97), but riders with disabilities can also contact [Para Transpo](#) ahead of time if additional service is required.

SHOPPING AND DINING

Situated in downtown Ottawa and adjacent to the Shaw Centre is [CF Rideau Centre](#), a premier shopping mall, home to nearly 200 retailers and nearly 20 eateries opened seven days a week.

While you are in the heart of the city don't miss the opportunity to visit the historical [ByWard Market](#) just steps away from the Shaw Centre with nearly 600 shops, boutiques, galleries, restaurants, cafes and much more.
