FOUNDATION MANDATE

The mandate of the Transportation Association of Canada (TAC) Foundation is to support the educational and research needs of the Canadian transportation industry. The objectives of the Foundation are as follows:

- To provide scholarships to Canadians and landed immigrants, who are attending educational establishments which are registered charities, and who are enrolled in full time transportation-related disciplines including:
 - » Transportation planning;
 - » Traffic management;
 - » Design of transportation infrastructure and public transportation;
 - » Program management;
 - » Environment monitoring and mitigation; and
 - » Operations, construction, and maintenance.
- To establish a program of internships and mentoring to encourage students enrolled in transportation-related disciplines at Canadian educational institutions.
- To establish or financially support academic chairs in Canadian educational institutions.
- To provide funding for transportation research and development at Canadian educational institutions.

The TAC Foundation, a registered charitable organization, was established by the Transportation Association of Canada to support and encourage a sustainable transportation industry.

FOUNDATION BACKGROUND

The Transportation Association of Canada (TAC) Foundation, a registered charity, was established by the Transportation Association of Canada in March 2003 to address the issue of shortages in the number of skilled people available for the planning, design, construction, operation and maintenance of Canada's transportation infrastructure.

The primary thrust of the TAC Foundation has been to significantly expand TAC's previous support of transportation education, both in terms of annual total dollars available to students in transportation programs and in scope. The expansion in scope is in reference to broadening the reach of the scholarship program beyond university graduate students, as well as to the implementation of other programs to support transportation education in Canada, such as high school mentoring programs and assistance to transportation educators and researchers.

ANNUAL FUNDING PROGRAM

The activities of the TAC Foundation are largely funded by annual donations from a diverse donor group.

Contributions are categorized by amount in the following manner.

Platinum Level represents a one-time donation of \$50,000 or more; or a contribution of \$10,000 or more per year for a minimum period of 5 years. The donor is able to be recognized through a “named” Foundation scholarship.

Gold Level represents a one-time donation of \$25,000 to \$49,999, or a contribution of \$5,000 per year or more for a minimum period of 5 years. As with the Platinum Level, the donor is able to be recognized through a “named” scholarship.

Silver Level represents a one-time donation of \$15,000 to \$24,999, or contributions of \$5,000 per year for a minimum of 3 years or \$3,000 per year for a minimum of 5 years. The donor with a contribution of \$5,000 per year is also able to be recognized through a “named” scholarship.

Bronze Level represents a donation to the Foundation of \$1,000 to \$14,999.

All other contributions to the Foundation are welcomed and are recognized as Friends of the Foundation.

PLANNED GIVING

Planned Giving enables donors to support the Foundation through future bequests or lifetime gifts which will be recognized at the following levels:

Platinum	\$50,000 or more
Gold	\$25,000 and over
Silver	\$15,000 and over
Bronze	\$1,000 and over

The Foundation will recognize bequests and other future commitments upon receipt of confirmation in writing that legal arrangements for the donation have been put in place (e.g. change to will).

Following confirmation of the gift, Planned Giving contributors will be acknowledged as “Legacy” donors in the Transportation Association of Canada’s newsletter, on the Foundation’s website and at the annual TAC conference during the year the gift is confirmed as well as the year in which it is received.

Major Legacy donors will be given appropriate additional recognition.

ENDOWMENT FUND

Donations to the TAC Foundation Endowment Fund create a capital pool from which interest and dividends will be used to support the Foundation programs. The target is to build a minimum endowment fund of \$2,000,000.
