

Request for Proposals - Addendum

Active Transportation Facilities at Interchanges

Addendum Issued: March 9, 2026

Deadline for proposals: March 24, 2026, 13:00 ET

Question 1: How does TAC expect to balance Canadian practice versus international examples in the synthesis, particularly where Canadian case studies are limited?

Response: TAC would typically expect that Canadian examples be prioritized in the synthesis and supplemented by international examples where Canadian practice is limited, with a clear discussion of their applicability to the Canadian context.

Question 2: Is TAC expecting a specific minimum number or range of case studies in the final report?

Response: There is no fixed number of case studies required. It is expected that the case studies will clearly illustrate which configurations work best for active transportation through urban interchanges across different project contexts (e.g., retrofit versus new construction), as well as lessons learned and broader insights from jurisdictional experience (including where approaches are not recommended).
