Working together this year an additional 16 scholarships were awarded totaling \$71,950 in funds to assist students pursue advanced education that will go to support Canada's transportation sector. That brings the total number of scholarships to 661 since 2004/05 with a value at nearly \$2.8 million. That is an incredible achievement.



The TAC Foundation is a registered charity established in 2003 to address the challenges associated with a shortage of skilled people available for planning, designing, constructing, operating and maintaining Canada's transportation infrastructure.

Fundraising

Fundraising is a critical priority for the Foundation. Its Executive Director and members of the Board invest significant energy in establishing and nurturing relationships with current and potential donors and communicating the value of supporting students in transportation-related programs of study. Those efforts have resulted in donations to the Foundation totalling approximately \$3.96 million since its establishment in 2003, with an additional \$89,000 committed for future years. The Foundation's past and future commitments have exceeded \$4 million.

The Foundation is grateful for the support received in 2025 from governments, private sector companies, and associations that provided for a generous scholarship program and enabled the Foundation's operations. Current donors and their cumulative contributions are listed later in this report.

Marketing and Communication

The main goals of the Foundation's Marketing and Communications Committee are to raise the profile of the TAC Foundation, enhance communication and collaboration and broaden outreach efforts. We aim to promote the Foundation's activities to attract valuable donors and high-caliber scholarship applicants. The communications strategy includes multiple messages promoting the programs to universities/colleges and TAC members in the educational institution category and encouraging active participation from scholarship recipients to promote the success stories of the Foundation's work. General and targeted posts are made across various platforms, including TAC News and the Foundation's own LinkedIn account.



Scholarships

Since the academic year 2004/05, the Foundation's Scholarship Program has awarded **661 scholarships valued at almost \$2.8 million to students** at the graduate, undergraduate (university and college) and entrance level in transportation-related disciplines.

In 2025, the Foundation was pleased to **award 16 scholarships totalling \$71,950**. A list of the 2025 scholarship recipients is contained herein and is also available on the Foundation website.

The Foundation gratefully acknowledges the leadership of Janelle Warren and Rebecca Farrugia and the contributions of more than 80 volunteers who reviewed scholarship applications this year.

AASHTO STEM Outreach Solutions

The Foundation champions the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) STEM Outreach Solutions (formerly TRAC) program in Canada. **Day-long sessions offer hands-on activities to introduce high school students to the world of transportation design and engineering**, seeking to inspire them to consider related careers. A successful event was held in Ottawa in November 2024 with support from Englobe, the Cement Association of Canada, Morrison Hershfield, TAC, and the Ottawa Carleton District School Board. **Another event is being planned for 2025**.

Student Activities Fund

For 2025, the Foundation has **allocated \$1,200** to its Student Activities Fund. Applications can be submitted by individuals or clubs/teams/associations pursuing field trips, educational experiences, and infrastructure or equipment, enhancing real-life learning opportunities and encouraging involvement in and selection of transportation-related studies and careers.


